16-19 Bursary Policy 2020-2021

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive a bursary the student must be aged under 19 on 31 August in the academic year in which they start their programme of study and must satisfy YPLA residency criteria.

To continue to receive a bursary students must satisfy the following conditions:

- 95% attendance
- Satisfactory progress
- Excellent conduct

Level 1 – Vulnerable Bursary

Eligible students include:

- Students in care, care leavers
- Students in receipt of income support or the equivalent Universal Credit
- Disabled students in receipt of employment support allowance who are also in receipt of disability living allowance.

Apply by completing the Bursary Application Form.

Level 2 - Discretionary Bursary

Eligible students include:

- Students on free school meals.

Bursary paid in 6 termly instalments

Apply by completing the Bursary Application Form.

Level 3 - Discretionary Bursary

Eligible students include:

Students who do not fall into Levels 1 or 2, with a household income below £25,000.

Bursary paid in 6 termly instalments
