RE: Updated Plans, March 2021

St Peter and St Paul Catholic Voluntary Academy are continuing to monitor and act on Government guidelines in relation to the national lockdown. We are aware, as I am sure that you will be too, from the Prime Minister's announcements yesterday that schools are to fully re-open on 8th March 2021. At this stage, however, there are still some details being clarified by the Government about what this will actually look like, especially around on-site testing of students and staff, as well as examinations for Years 11 and 13.

As such, I will write to you again either late this week or early next week once we have received the complete guidance from the Government's Department for Education to outline our plans for all students returning to school from 8th March 2021.

In the meantime, the following will continue for the duration of the partial school closure:

- If your child is in Year 7 to Year 11 and is vulnerable, or you as their parent/carer are a keyworker, then you must contact us on sspp@sspp.lincs.sch.uk to inform us if you would like your child to attend the Academy – they will need to bring a packed lunch each day. These students will finish at 3:15pm each day to coincide with the end of remote learning and live lessons.
