Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am writing to update you on the plans for Year 11 as we seek to provide a continuity of education for all students in Year 11 up to, and including, Friday 25th June 2021.

Firstly, there will be a liturgy and celebration for students during Period 6 of Friday 28th May 2021, this will be an opportunity for students to come together and reflect on their time here at the Academy.

Secondly, directly following half-term, in the weeks beginning 7th and 14th June 2021, the following provision will be in place:

- Students will be able to access Bridging Units through Teams that will prepare them for post-16 study, especially if they are staying with us at St Peter and St Paul into Sixth Form.
- Students will also be able to access a wealth of resources based around their interests, to be found in the "Bridging Work" Teams, covering many areas such as writing a CV, watching online lectures and completing MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses)
- On Monday 7th and Monday 14th during morning a Tutor time session (8:40-9:05am) will be compulsory for students to attend via Teams
- On Thursday 10th and Thursday 17th during morning Tutor time (8:40-9:05am) a Careers and Personal Development session will take place
- During every period of the day from Monday 7th June to Friday 18th June teachers will be available. All students will be able to 'Teams call' the member of staff detailed below to discuss work or pastoral issues:

Students can attend any lessons of interest and are not bound by the choices already made, and can feel free to explore as many subjects as possible.
