<b>Year 11</b>	<p><a href="#"><u>Component 2</u></a></p> <p>Students are assessed internally through a controlled assessment process, involving moderated preparation and presentation of a business plan and a pitch for a new enterprise activity.</p> <p><a href="#"><u>Component 3</u></a></p> <p>Students are externally assessed by a Pearson-set exam.</p> <p>The Component 2 set assignment is written by Pearson each year. Work is completed under supervised conditions in class time and is graded through centre-assessed mark bands. Grades are awarded by Pearson based on Component 1 (completed in Year 10), Component 2 and Component 3.</p> <p>Support sessions will be available every Tuesday afterschool in ICT 1 to support with coursework and revision.</p>
