### Three Key Pathways

### **Options**



#### Academic

Students will take GCSEs and aim to achieve the English Baccalaureate (EBacc).

#### **Academic Vocational**

Students will opt for a range of GCSEs, BTEC or OCR vocational subjects.

#### Access

Students will be guided in their options which may include GCSE, Entry Level, Level 1 and 2 in vocational subjects along with skills for personal and working life.

Students in current groups OAK, ASH and ELM plus other suitable candidates

will follow the Academic Pathway; selecting at least one humanity subject and one language.

#### **Students in current groups YEW**

may follow either the Academic or Academic Vocational Pathway but should consider taking either one humanity subject, one language or Computer Science as a minimum.
